

Dating from 1895, this preserved railway takes you from the village of Fairbourne, in the shadow of Snowdonia, along the beaches of Cardigan Bay and the Mawddach Estuary to the mouth of the Mawddach at Barmouth Ferry Station. Children love the journey! The engines are not too big and there is plenty to see and do. If this is your first visit we don't think it will be your last!



BARMOUTH FERRY STATION
Meet the ferry, which runs across the Mawddach Estuary between Barmouth and the Harbour View Café. Food is available here on green and blue timetable days.

ESTUARY HALT
Close to the Tunnel, car park, slipway and beaches.

LOOP HALT
Here trains pass each other. Alight for the Embankment Footpath to take the scenic walk to Barmouth.

GOLF HALT
A round of Golf at the 9 hole, Par 3 course is available here.

BEACH HALT
Break your journey here for Fairbourne's long, sandy beaches.

FAIRBOURNE STATION
The station is home to the Railway and has attractions for all, including souvenir sales, our Railway Museum, a Garden Scale model railway and our new indoor play area. The welcoming and relaxing station café plays a selection of DVD footage.

The unique Barmouth Bridge carries the Cambrian Coast Railway across the Mawddach Estuary. The bridge is also open to walkers with a separate footway running alongside the line which provides for a round trip via the Fairbourne Miniature Railway, the Barmouth Ferry and the Embankment Footpath.
